













ENGLISH CHAMP READING COMPETITION








WARM CLOTHES COLLECTED 28.11.2020








CPS ENGLISH CHAMP - DICTATION

The main purpose behind conducting such competitions is to build self confidence, develop the oratory skills, self expression and above all to understand the beauty penned down by such great poets.












National Youth Day Celebration









ENGLISH CHAMP'The Patriot Speaks'


ENGLISH CHAMP: TWISTED TALES

Stories and Story telling has been an age-old practice to teach Children, a way of life. The students of classes III to V were given a list of stories from the classic collection like King








Virtual PTM at CPS: Discussion of SOP issued by government before reopening of physical school

The excitement of coming back to school after a long break could be seen on the faces of children and teachers alike. The students attended their classes following the COVID-19 guidelines.



















An interclass calligraphy competition was organised for the students of III - VIII . Students shared the pics of the paragraphs and words written in their beautiful handwritings.







ACTIVITY CLASS:







CPS Road Safety Club organized virtual Quiz Competition for classes III to V on Feb 01, 2021 to initiate Road Safety alertness and awareness.


































