## **Post Card Campaign**












In this digital world when the dictionary is forgotten, CPS motivates students to use it. CPS conducts the fastest finger first competition as a part of monthly competitions.


### **English Champ Competition: Panel Discussion**

One such conference was conducted by I.I.M.U.N. in the city of Udaipur in association with Central Public School, Udaipur. Central Public School played host in presenting





























# उदयपुर के फुटबॉलर नाजीर का चयन जर्मन क्लब में





GRADE I TO VIII STUDENTS DISPLAYING THEIR ENGLISH CALLIGRAPHY

















"Creativity is just connecting the thoughts and spreading awareness."



Students created and decorated Tricolour Bookmarks as Republic Day theme using innovative ideas to make them look more interesting..


The objective of this competition was to encourage reading among the young children, as well as to give them an opportunity to express and develop their creativity and also to enthuse the feeling of pride for their country.


